The premise of the project is simple; to give a spider plant to a wide range of family, friends and associates.

In recognition of the growing problem with climate change, this small project explores ideas of social networking and atmospheric pollution. It wonders whether, through small pieces of direct action, we can make a difference. It celebrates the natural cycles of growing and propagating. Spider plants, with a little care, multiply prolifically and, as with many plants, are beneficial to their immediate environment.

Recipient Clause

Recipients must agree to declare which locality the plant will reside in, and submit a photograph of the plant in situ. Only by registering their plant with the web site, does the recipient validate that it is a genuine Nick Cass Spider Plant multiple work of art.

Propagation & Distribution Clause

Those who accept a plant may, at their discretion, become assistants in this project. They may grow multiples of their plant and distribute them, along with copies of this agreement, to whomsoever they choose. In doing so, these multiples are also recognised as original Nick Cass works of art, as long as the photograph submission guidelines are adhered to.
